

Dominion Energy South Carolina, Inc. (DESC) filed an application on March 31, 2023 to increase its natural gas rates by approximately 6.22% with the Public Service Commission of South Carolina (PSC). The average residential consumer's monthly natural gas bill would increase by \$3.95 per month, if approved. The case is scheduled to be considered by the PSC in August 2023 with new rates effective in October 2023.

About Dominion Energy South Carolina's Rate Increase Request

- If approved, the average residential consumer's monthly natural gas bill would increase by \$3.95 (~6.22%) per month.
- The average commercial customer's (Rate 31) monthly natural gas bill would increase by ~6.22% per month.
- Commercial customers under Rate 33 and industrial customers would see no change.

About the Office of Regulatory Staff

The ORS represents consumers of investor-owned utilities in South Carolina before the PSC. The PSC is the state agency that sets utilities' rates. The ORS must look at the impact to the consumer and utilities' continued investment in reliable and high-quality services.
