

**SOUTH CAROLINA OFFICE OF REGULATORY STAFF  
CHAPTER 111**

Statutory Authority: 1976 Code Section 58-27-2620,58-27-2630, 58-27-2640, 58-27-2660

**Notice of Drafting:**

The South Carolina Office of Regulatory Staff proposes to promulgate Regulation 111-10, to provide consumer protection parameters applicable to the lease of renewable energy generation facilities, including disclosure requirements, pursuant to Section 58-27-2660. Interested parties are invited to present their views in writing to Andrew Bateman, General Counsel, South Carolina Office of Regulatory Staff, 1401 Main Street Suite 850, Columbia, SC 29201. To be considered, comments must be received no later than 5 p.m. February 3, 2020, the close of the drafting comment period.

**Synopsis:**

The ORS proposes to promulgate Regulation 111-10 to provide a consumer protection framework applicable to the lease of renewable energy generation facilities. Section 58-27-2660(A)(1) provides that the Department of Consumer Affairs and the Office of Regulatory Staff develop such consumer protection regulations, which shall, at a minimum, include appropriate disclosures to be made by sellers and lessors.

The regulation will require legislative review.
