 - Beaufort, Berkeley, Charleston, Colleton, Dorchester, Georgetown, Horry and Jasper
- General Permits: Critical Area Permitting
 - In tideland critical areas: GP-96-001 for Directional boring for utilities
 - In beach/dune system critical areas: GP-90-A Installation or repair of underground and overhead water, sewer, gas, electrical, telephone and cable service lines
- Coastal Zone Consistency
