Accuracy was determined utilizing GPS with sub-meter equipment with as built staking sheets, then as built staking sheets were used to implement sequential numbers on the fiber. The total fiber length was 38,530 feet: 16,992 feet of fiber were constructed outside of the unserved area, and 21,538 feet were constructed feet within the unserved area.
