Charleston

Many of the census blocks located within the Awendaw and McClellanville areas of Charleston County are either served or in the process of being served by Home Telecom as part of the USDA's ReConnect project. The attached map, labeled as Exhibit A, demonstrates where Home Telecom is building fiber-to-the-home broadband compared to Comcast's SFRF application. Shapefiles can be provided upon request.

Construction in these areas is well underway, and customers are in the process of being connected with service. Under Home's currently funded project, approximately 50% of the census blocks within Comcast's application will be served by the end of 2023. The approval of Comcast's application for the census blocks located within the Awendaw and McClellanville areas means these areas will be overbuilt with funding that could be used in other unserved areas of rural South Carolina.
