


## **Applicant(s) Current Status**

SC BEAD Applicants that have chosen to move forward with locations selected by the SCBBO are to provide additional gating documentation in accordance with NTIA BEAD requirements.


### **Applicant(s) Current Status**

- Selected BSLs / Total (proposed) BEAD funds award and where to find the file
- Use as a basis for compilation of all remaining gating requirements

#### Remaining Gating Documentation Required Cont'd

Attachments Due if Chosen for a Prospective Subaward (potentially due later):	
☐ Financial Capability Attachments [BEAD Main Application and Financial Capability Attachments subfolder]	
□A letter from a bank that meets eligibility requirements consistent with those set forth in 47 C.F.R. § 54.804(c)(2) committing to issue an irrevocable standby Letter of Credit, in the required form (see SCBBO model Letter of Credit template). Or if a performance bond is chosen, the Applicant must submit a letter from a certified surety on federal bonds committing to issue the Applicant a performance bond upon award.	
□ Legal Opinion Letter - Reminder for applicants providing a letter of credit:  The Applicant, at the time of Selection, prior to award, will be required to obtain a Letter of Credit accompanied by an opinion letter from third party legal counsel. The opinion letter must clearly state the following: subject only to customary assumptions, limitations, and qualifications, that in a proceeding under Title 11 of the United States Code, 11 U.S.C. § 101 et seq. (the "Bankruptcy Code"), the bankruptcy court would not treat the Letter of Credit or proceeds of the Letter of Credit as property of the winning subgrantee's bankruptcy estate under Section 541 of the Bankruptcy Code. When a Letter of Credit is submitted, include an Opinion Letter from legal counsel asserting that in bankruptcy proceedings the Letter of Credit or its proceeds will not be treated as the subgrantee's bankruptcy estate property, subject only to customary assumptions. limitations, and qualifications.	
$\square$ Business plans with sufficient detail to evidence Project sustainability	
$\hfill \Box$ Evidence of having the necessary funds to cover all project costs that exceed the amount of the grant	

- 1. Letter for LOC OR Letter from a certified surety for Bond
- 2. IF LOC Legal Opinion Letter
- 3. Business Plans evidencing project sustainability
- 4. Evidence of funds available to cover all project costs (e.g. recent bank statement along with recent bank reconciliation)
- 5. Audited Financials (Updates)

pplicants that have not provided audited financials or provided unaudited financial ents at the time of Pre-Qualification:
$\hfill\Box$ Financial statements audited by independent certified public accountant for the prior fiscal or calendar year
☐ Single Audits and/or any other audits related to federal funding within the past 5 (five) years (if applicable).

#### The Letter for the LOC or BOND - Due now

Actual LOC or BOND <u>IS NOT</u> currently due No Template for the Letter - Three Requirements:

- Issuing Bank or Certified Surety must commit to issue an irrevocable standby LOC or Performance Bond
- 2. The commitment letter shall at a minimum include the dollar amount
  - LOC = 10% of the subaward amount
  - BOND = 100% of the subaward amount
- 3. Issuing Bank or Surety agrees to follow the terms and conditions of the template letter of credit or template performance bond

### Remaining Gating Documentation Required Cont'd

- ☐ Managerial Capability Attachments [BEAD Main Application and Managerial Capability Attachments subfolder]
- 6. One-page resumes for key management personnel and certifying engineers, including, name, tile, relevant licenses including the license number, and three examples of relevant experiences, as well as contractors and subcontractors
  - One page per resume, per "Key Management Personnel"
  - Within the page there should be examples of relevant work experience related to role on project team
  - Certifying Engineers are considered "Key Management Personnel"
  - Contractors and Subcontractors should be included if considered

- Remember to fill out both tabs
- "Awarded Broadband Projects"
   (Anticipate seeing <u>active</u> State and County ARPA/RDOF/Reconnect awards)
- "Potential Broadband Projects"
   (Anticipate seeing non-active projects for which ISP has previously bid)
  - No need to include SC BEAD Bid
- ☐ Other Public Funding Attachments [BEAD Main Application and Other Public Funding Attachment subfolder]



- 8. Certification letter from a
  Professional Engineer9. PDF Map of Network Design10. GIS Data (fully attributed) that created PDF Map (see data dictionary)
- 11. Network Diagram (PDF)
- 12. Capital Investment Schedule
- 13. Project Timeline
- Network Design should be high-level design in terms of scope and detail
- PE DOES NOT have to be Licensed in South Carolina

#### **Best Practices**

- Notify SCBBO immediately with issues
- Always use ShareFile for BEAD Attachments
  - Do not email BEAD@ors with gating documentation
  - Files SCBBO share with Applicant will be stored in "ORS MODS" folder
- Designate confidential files accordingly
