Office of Regulatory Staff New Nuclear Development Update Report V.C. Summer Units 2 & 3

During the week of February 12, 2018, Office of Regulatory Staff – New Nuclear Development personnel (NND Personnel) worked at the V.C. Summer site on Monday.

On Monday February 12, NND Personnel attended the Plan of the Day meeting which focused on safety, SCE&G security and demobilization/abandonment of the site. The following activities were discussed during the meeting:

- Reduction of on-site staff
- The auction company continued to remove Westinghouse Electric Company (WEC) equipment from the site. Over 400 truckloads of WEC equipment have been removed over the last 3 weeks.
- Continue to remove contractor trailers from the site
- Concrete batch plant constituent removal
- Recovery of vendor equipment

After the meeting, the SCE&G Abandonment Manager reported that SCE&G was working to finalize the sale of plant equipment to Southern Nuclear for Plant Vogtle.

This equipment was originally identified in a Southern Nuclear Letter of Intent (LOI) in December of 2017. The equipment identified in the LOI ranges from small commodities (e.g., rebar) to large components such as two reactor coolant pumps and main steam isolation valves. The LOI states that the purchase must be approved by SCE&G, Santee Cooper, WEC, and Southern Nuclear as well as the Public Service Commission of S.C. (PSC), for items greater than \$1 million in value.

Additionally, SCE&G is working to recover the funds from WEC for the reactor coolant pump SN508 originally planned for use at the V.C. Summer site, which was transferred by WEC to China's State Nuclear Power Technology Corporation Haiyang Unit 2 project in late 2017.

The reactor coolant pump SN508 was referenced in SCE&G's December 27, 2017 letter to the PSC filed in Docket 2017-305-E. SCE&G's request was approved by the PSC in Order 2018-82, dated January 31, 2018.
